Evaluation Comments

Smith Seckman Reid Inc

Strengths

Offeror provided detailed explanation of software to be used in the energy modeling process. Offeror gave several examples of requested LEED certified projects. Offeror detailed specific team members to projects for Metro. Offeror kept documents within requested limits.

Weaknesses

Offeror lacked demonstration of Net Zero experience. Provided generalized information on energy modeling process, lacked organization-specific detail past the initial phase. Lacked detail on energy conservation and how energy saving was prioritized. Lacked explanation on how energy loads changed designs. Offeror lacked detail on new construction experience

TLC Engineering for Architecture Inc

Strengths

Offeror provided detailed explanation of software to be used in the energy modeling process. Offeror demonstrated past Net Zero Experience. Offeror provided details on energy conservation and prioritization measures. Offeror gave detail on how energy loads effected designs. Offeror presented detailed description of new construction experience.

Weaknesses

Proposal lacked requested examples of projects where the firm developed energy models during the design phase. Proposal lacked detail on organization-specific processes on building energy modeling. Insufficient information provided on specific members on projects for Metro. Offeror did not give information specific for approach to Metro's project requirements. Documents submitted exceeded size limit.
