Belinda Stewart Architects PA

Strengths

Firm's proposal demonstrated minimal use of change orders on reference projects. Firm proposed project software to help monitor projects. Firm' s proposal demonstrates firm meets Secretary of Interior Standards, Preservation of Historic Concrete and Architectural Engineering. Firm's proposal demonstrated expertise in Historic concrete experience. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Firm's proposal demonstrated more Architectural experience than Conservational experience. Firm's proposal lacked details for materials testing. Firm's proposed timeline exceeds Metro's expectations. Firm's provided reference projects were not directly related or of similar scope to that of Centennial Park scope of work. Firm's proposal demonstrates firm will heavy rely on subcontractors for completion of work.

Cornerstone Engineering Inc

Strengths

Firm's proposal identified five (5) Metro structures with noted difficulties. Firm provided initial assessment with proposal. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm meets Secretary of Interior Standards, Preservation of Historic Concrete and Architectural Engineering. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Firm's proposal lacked detail for methodology and approach. Firm failed to provide a detailed project timeline. Firm's proposal was lacked detail for project tasks, proposal was unclear of who would perform what task. Firm's proposal demonstrated lack of understanding of scope of services, proposal addressed repair services plan, RFQ does not include repair services. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm has limited concrete structure experience.

Cultural Heritage Conservation LLC

Strengths

Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's experience and focus on Conservation projects. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's knowledge of John Earley Architectural Concrete process. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's knowledge of step by step method process. Firm proposed plan to produce a matrix of findings. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's expertise in non-disruptive concrete. Firm's proposal demonstrated proposed team's deep specialized expertise for scope of work. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's experience on high profile public projects. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Firm failed to provide detailed project timeline. Firm's proposal failed to demonstrate the use of an Architect during the project.

Strengths

Firm's proposal demonstrated strong test facilities capabilities. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm meets Secretary of Interior Standards. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's experience on public projects. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Proposal formatting was not as requested in pre offer and solicitation. Firm's proposal suggested the use of drones and/or lifts at an additional cost to Metro per assessment. Firm's proposal was unclear as to how the assessments would be conducted. Firm's proposal lacked detail for proposed sampling and testing, the processes were unclear. Firm's proposed project timeline lacked detail. Firm's provided projects were not similar to scope of work for this solicitation. Firm's proposal demonstrated limited Historic concrete experience. Firm's proposal demonstrated limited Conservation experience.
