Strengths – General Detailed explanation of the process used to perform the scope of services.

Weaknesses – Failed to a description of the services provided and the length of time the services were provided to the customer within the qualifications and experience criteria; failed to provide subcontractor experience and how subcontractors will be utilized; submitted contractor’s license copy and information enter into response to the solicitation are different; submitted certification show as expired; failed to provide detailed narrative describing the approach your company would take to completed the necessary work as recommended in the reports for each site.

Emergency Response Team

Strengths – Strong detailed approach narrative describing how the work will be completed as recommended in the reports for each site; “all challenges will be identified, addressed, solved and agreed upon with proper planning and coordination with Metro”;

Weaknesses – lack of experience with governmental agencies; failed to provide contact information for project experience; numerous attached failed to following formatting requirement which made it difficult to follow; cost; contractor’s license limit

TPM

Strengths – Strong detailed qualifications and experience that demonstrated project experience similar of size, scope, and complexity; Metro Nashville experience

Weaknesses – length of resumes make it difficult to follow; contractor’s license limit; approach was detailed but failed to include a detailed approach narrative describing how the work will be completed as recommended in the reports for each site.
