

The following table shows the databases that I have requested as a staff member at Metro Nashville Community Oversight and contrasts the requests I made previously with the current requests. All the previous requests listed led to the production of electronic documents. Each request as a private citizen included a charge for storage media (currently \$1.10 for a CD, \$1.60 for a DVD, and \$8 for a thumb drive).
