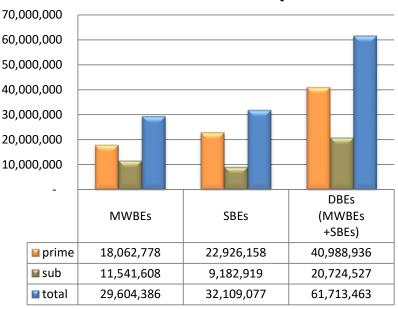

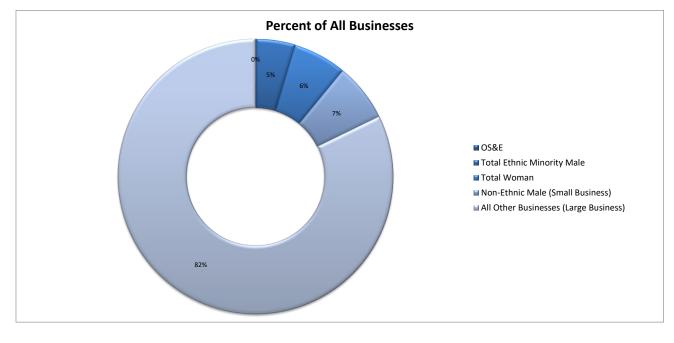

Metropolitan Government of Nashville & Davidson County EBO and Outreach Update FY20 - 1st Quarter (July- September 2019)

Important points to note about the EBO Program which launched on July 5, 2019:

2.	14.8 million is the total estimated spend with minority or woman owned businesses;
	a. 6.0 million is the total estimated spend with minority owned businesses;
	b. 8.8 million is the total estimated spend with woman owned businesses;
3.	is the combined goal for minority or woman owned business participation;
	a. 6% is the average goal for minority owned business participation;
	b. 7% is the average goal for woman owned business participation.
4.	By comparison, in the previous fiscal year, the total participation rate for minority and woman owner cousinesses was 6% combined. Metro is already on track to double that if the current trend holds.

1. The Metro Government released **18** solicitations that had race and gender conscious goals.
