Metropolitan Government of Nashville & Davidson County EBO and Outreach Update

FY20 - 2nd Quarter (October- December 2019)

Important points to note about the EBO Program which launched on July 5, 2019:

2.	43.4 million is the total estimated spend with minority or woman owned businesses;
	a. 14.5 million is the total estimated spend with minority owned businesses;
	b. 28.9 million is the total estimated spend with woman owned businesses;
3.	is the combined goal for minority or woman owned business participation;
	a. 11% is the average goal for minority owned business participation;
	b. 14% is the average goal for woman owned business participation.
4.	By comparison, in the previous fiscal year, the total participation rate for minority and woman owned businesses was 6% combined .
