1. What services does your organization provide to the residents of Davidson County?

We currently work closely with men who have been released from our prison system here in Davidson county and surrounding areas. We offer help in getting proper identification such as drivers license and social security cards. We locate for our clients living wage employment jobs which they can support themselves and their families. We offer GED high school education resources along with continuing education guidance along with available scholarships, grants and loans. We help locate housing for our clients as well as provide items needed to start a new residence.

2. How many residents are you currentl serving and how do they benefit?

I work with residence at Dismas House on a volunteer for many years. I believe there are no more than 20 clients at a time on a rotating basis. I have been serving there for over a decade.

3. How much funding are you requesting from Metro?

I am requesting \$15,000 from Metro funding.

4. If funding is awarded, how many additional residents will be served and how will they benefit?

We would be able to start a small food bank for the needy as well as provide air conditioning units for the elderly and disabled when Metro Action Commission has exhausted their supply.

5. In addition to serving more residents, are there other community benefits Metro funding would help you achieve?

Semi annual food drive/giveaway, xmas toy drive giveaway for needy children and feeding the homeless and poor people.

6. How would you use this funding to help create a more equitable Nashville, where all residents have an opportunity to participate in the city's success?

Giving all clients an opportunity to register to vote. (Help also with reinstating voting rights if this apply.) Continuing education offered to all clients. Credit counseling and live within your means lectures. Keys to buying and maintaining home ownership. How to avoid forclosures lectures.
