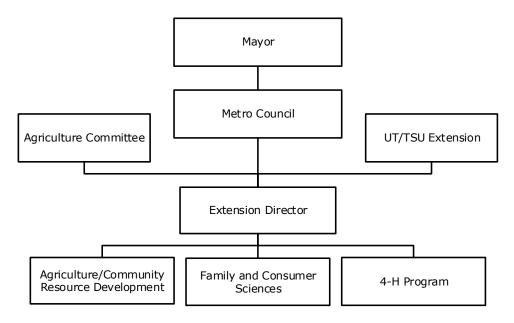
Mission
