Fiscal Year 2007

The Metro Department of Finance's Office of Management and Budget is pleased to present this update to the Revenue Reference Guide, reflecting on Fiscal Year 2007. This document indicates the various sources of revenue for the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County as well as the numerous uses of those revenue dollars. Also included, when applicable, is the legal authorization that permits Metro to collect dollars through the assessment of fees, fines, and permits. The data included reflects the information that has been provided by Metro departments and agencies to the Office of Management and Budget. The data is accurate as of September 6, 2007, since the fiscal year end close process had not been completed. Please note that not all Metro departments and revenue accounts are included within this manual. The following departments have been excluded:

- District Energy System (DES)
- Hospital Authority Metro Nashville General Hospital, Knowles Home, and Bordeaux Long-Term Care Home
- Metro Nashville Public Schools (MNPS) and Community Education Alliance
- Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA)
