

Air Curtain:

An operational permit is required for the kindling or maintaining of an open fire or fire on any public street, alley, road or other public or private ground. This permit is a two part and will only be issued in conjunction with an Air Curtain Permit from the Metro Nashville Health Department.

Conditions of this permit are as follows:

- Obtain an Air Pollutant Source Operating Permit from Metro Health Department
- Keep land clearing material below the “air curtain” at all times
- Do not overfill the pit at any time
- Place the material in the pit: do not push the material into the pit
- All ash must be saturated with water before removal from the pit
- Permit is only valid on days when the air quality is in the good or moderate range
- Inspection may be required
