Amusement Building:

Permits for the Operation of an Amusement Building are required when the occupancy meets the definition of Special Amusement Building (see below). Examples include but may not be limited to: Haunted Houses, Mazes, House of Mirrors, Escape Rooms, etc.

SPECIAL AMUSEMENT BUILDING. A building that is temporary, permanent or mobile that contains a device or system that conveys passengers or provides a walkway along, around or over a course in any direction as a form of amusement arranged so that the egress path is not readily apparent due to visual or audio distractions or an intentionally confounded egress path, or is not readily available because of the mode of conveyance through the building or structure.

Conditions of this permit are as follows:

- Automatic Sprinklers are required
- Smoke/heat detection is required
- Fire alarm system is required
- Exit signage required
- Emergency lights are required
- Emergency action plan must be provided
- Staff must be trained on emergency evacuation procedures
- Fire Inspection will be required
- Portable fire extinguishers shall be provided with a current tag,
- Exit doors to be unlocked when building occupied (Escape games must be visually monitored when occupied)
- Must provide a floor plan indicating the square footage and layout diagram showing exits

During the application process be prepared to download the following documents: 1) Annual Fire Alarm ITM Report 2) Annual Sprinkler ITM Report 3) Inside Building Layout 4) Outside Site Layout 5) Emergency Vehicle Access Plan 6) Proof of Insurance
