Concession Trailer/Food Truck (Mobile):

An Operational Permit is required for the operation of Mobile Concession Trailer/Food Truck.

The definition for Mobile Concession Trailer/Food Truck: A motorized vehicle or a trailer equipped with facilities to cook (hood exhaust or extinguishing system), prepare and sell food.

NOTE: Vehicles that are permanently located on a parcel and attached to fixed drains, water lines, and/or electricity must have a permit from the Metro Building/Codes Department and be treated as a permanent structure to be located on that property. Permanently fixed food trucks or trailers using propane are also required to have an LPG permit annually. If your food truck is permanently located on a property **DO NOT** use the Mobile Concession Trailer/Food Truck Permit. Permanent Concession Trailers/Food Trucks See FAQ's

Conditions of this permit are as follows:

- An Inspection is required.
- Vehicles must be 10 feet away from buildings and other food trucks/concession trailers
- Fire extinguishers are required (Class K and 2A 40BC), must have a current tag from a licensed fire extinguisher contractor and shall be mounted in the vehicle.
- Extinguishing systems and hoods must be clean and properly serviced with a current service tag from a licensed contractor.
- Propane tank shall be secured in the upright position.

During the application process be prepared to download the following documents: 1) License plate number for the vehicle to be permitted, 2) Copy of paperwork showing extinguishing system has been serviced, 3) Copy of your Fire Extinguisher Tag(s)
