

Pyro and Flame Effects:

An operational permit is required for the storage, handling and use of explosives, fireworks or pyrotechnic special effects.

****MUST APPLY WITH THE STATE OF TENNESSEE FIRST****

Conditions of this permit are as follows:

- Inspection required before and after event
- Provide a diagram of the location, including the discharge site
- Diagram should show buildings, highways, overhead obstructions and utilities and the audience restrained lines
- Diagram should also indicate fireworks fallout area
- Separation distances, sequence of operations are required
- Provide the procedures and actions to be taken for misfired shells
- Provide multiple fire extinguishers
- Operator must be approved and licensed by the State of Tennessee
- Acceptable fireworks: Division 1.30, 1.4G, 1.4S and pyrotechnic articles

During the application process be prepared to download the following documents: 1) State of Tennessee Firework Display Operator's License, 2) List of fireworks and D.O.T. classification, 3) Firing or launch diagram, 4) List of flame effects and effect types, 5) Insurance certificate (with Metropolitan Government of Nashville, Davidson County listed as an additional insured), 6) List of safety precautions 7) Copy of the State of Tennessee Fireworks Application
