REGULATION NO. 15

TITLE IV - ACID DEPOSITION CONTROL

This Regulation establishes requirements for the issuances of Federal Acid Rain Permit for any affected facility in Metropolitan Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee. This Regulation is promulgated as provided for in Section 10.56.090, "Board - Powers and Duties," of the Metropolitan Code of Laws.

SECTION 15-1

The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee, hereby adopts and incorporates by references the provisions of 40 CFR Part 72 as in effect on November 15, 1993, for purposes of implementing an acid rain program that meets the requirements of Title IV of the Clean Air Act. The term "permitting authority" shall mean the Metropolitan Health Department, Pollution Control Division, and the term "Administrator" shall mean the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

If the provisions or requirements of 40 CFR Part 72 conflicts with or are not included in the Metropolitan Health Department, Pollution Control Division's Regulation No. 13, "Part 70 - Operating Permit Program," the Part 72 provisions and requirements shall apply and take precedence.
