What's needed:

- ✓ **Birth Certificate**
- ✓ **Proof of Income** (IRS 1040 for 2018)
- ✓ **Current Shot Record** (White form with Tennessee seal)
- ✓ **Insurance Card for the child** (if they have insurance)
- ✓ **Proof of Residency** (such as a utility or phone bill)
- ✓ **Photo ID for parents**
