# Head Start/Early Head Start Program

Is your child eligible for enrollment?

#### If your child has an IEP/IFSP or a diagnosed disability, such as

\* Autism \*Developmental Delay \* Hearing or Visual Impairment

He/she could qualify for enrollment in Early Head Start (for ages birth to three years), or Head Start (for ages three to five years)

#### **Head Start/Early Head Start Provides:**

\*A focus on quality early childhood education, wellness, and school readiness
\*Educational field trips for Head Start

\*Free health and developmental screenings, such as hearing, vision, dental, and speech/lanugage
\*Nutritional Meals (We accommodate special diets)

\* There is no fee for this program (with the exception of before/after care)

\* School hours are from 8am-2pm, Monday-Friday.

Metropolitan Action Commission serves children and families at 10 locations in Nashville/Davidson County.
