## E.S. Rose Park Sports Complex

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## Background/History

E.S. Rose Park Athletic Complex is a state-of-the-art, 24-acre community facility which includes athletic fields, a basketball court, walking track, and a NCAA Division I standards training facility. Located in the historic Edgehill Civil War battleground area, the E.S. Rose Park athletic fields are a revolutionary shared use facilities concept between the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation and Belmont University. Metro Parks' owns, controls, and manages the scheduling of E.S. Rose Park athletic fields.

In addition to athletic offerings, the partnership promotes new and improved collaborations between Metro Parks, Carter Lawrence Elementary School, Rose Park Middle School, local neighborhood organizations, and nearby Belmont University. The park is open to the public from dawn to dusk except when a scheduled event is reserved at the facility.

## Purpose

In 2007, Metro Parks entered into an agreement with Belmont University to construct athletic fields in E.S. Rose Park to be used by the general public and the university's sports teams.

This shared use agreement requires Belmont to make lease payments of \$50K per year (with a 3\% annual increase) to Metro Parks. The agreement stipulates that $20 \%$ of the lease payment be equally divided between the Parent Teacher Organizations (PTOs) of Rose Park and Carter Lawrence Magnet Schools.

The agreement also requires Belmont to bear the cost of utilities related to its use of the facilities and to provide maintenance and repair services during its respective sports' competitive seasons.

## Scholarships

Belmont created the E.S. Rose Scholarship in memory of Reverend E.S. Rose, who was pastor of the city's Greater Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church from 1928-1944, and a wellknown community activist.

The scholarship program awards two four-year, full-tuition scholarships each academic year. Every other year, one additional four-year, half-tuition scholarship is awarded.

Selection is based upon academic accomplishment, leadership (in school and community) and demonstrated financial need.

Priority consideration is given to students living in closest proximity to the Edgehill neighborhood and who submit and complete an application for admission to the University by December 1 of each year.

Scholarship recipients agree to perform 20 hours of community service each academic year in the E.S. Rose Park and Edgehill neighborhoods.

In FY 14, E.S. Rose Scholarship funds totaled \$173,294.00.

## Belmont's Maintenance and Improvement Expenses

In FY14, Belmont spent $\$ 91,740$ on maintenance and improvement expenses at E.S. Rose Park.
