Curb Extensions




Curb extensions, also known as bulb outs, pull out the curb at the intersection, in the space where parking would typically go. This accomplishes three main things:

- 1. Stops people from parking too close to the intersection or using the space as a turn lane
- 2. Calms traffic by narrowing the street as drivers approach, and by forcing sharper turns
- 3. Shortens the distance people walking and biking have to cross in traffic (on Belmont Boulevard the distance will go from 50 feet to only 21 feet)


*Curb extensions can be done with paint and plastic bollards to save on cost and/or test things out.

Additionally, they can be designed to protect bike lanes, provide better bus stop access, and incorporate art into the street.




