Any thoughts on how can we improve the process?

- For the areas with major concerns – address the homeowners. As the process moves forward it would be great if the developers were required to meet with homeowners within a 2 mile radius of their development. This would help the process and truly keep the citizens in the know. Everyone doesn't use computers. Lots of those in the area are seniors who moved in 70s – and there is a huge gap in communication.
- Really let it be something from the start.
- Start sooner. This seems rushed to get to a plan in 3 days. Again, seems like the plan may already be in place or be outlined.
- Better communicate the process ahead of time to draw more people.
- I like the process as is. I like the process of input. We are all in agreement of the improvements after listening to each tables explanations. Anything can be improved with a little thought and research.
- Explain process of reviewing and making decisions on all the table maps.
- Perhaps 5 more minutes per task. Once people get involved, they worried about the time less.
