 - Sketches of aspects of transit, street trees, on-street dining, loading areas, parking that people mentioned at listening session.
- Visioning Workshop
 - Breakout Session (1 hr. 10 mins.)
 - Base map of focus area – 2nd Ave Area (riverfront/1st to 3rd, Broadway to Union)
 - InVision (online mapping tool) base map orientation – each facilitator/drawer orients their group to the map and key locations.
 - Introductions of each participant
 - Group Facilitator: We've heard key themes from the listening sessions (such as importance of street trees, importance of historic character, activating the riverfront) and seen elements in the inspiration sketches. As you move around the 2nd Avenue area, how do you want different areas to feel? How do you want the area to flow? What do you want to be amazed by?
 - *Decision to keep this question very open and not directed in any way*
 - 4 areas:
 - 2nd Avenue – Broadway to Commerce (15 mins.)
 - 2nd Avenue – Commerce to Church (inc. AT&T bldg.) (15 mins.)
 - 2nd Avenue – Church to Union (10 mins.)
 - First Avenue & riverfront (20 mins.)
 - Report back from each group (2-3 mins. per group – total 30 mins.)
 - *Facilitator share their screen and facilitator and sketcher provide overview.*
