A WALKABLE & CONNECTED JEFFERSON STREET

Perform an inventory and assessment of the corridor to identify key areas of improvement and opportunity to make the Jefferson Street Corridor friendly and accessible for all ages and abilities.

Provide multi-modal transit options along the Jefferson Street Corridor to promote walkability and improved connectivity.



I-40 IMPROVEMENTS

Examine and assess the existing conditions to build upon the vision and ideas established in the design workshops.

Explore an extended lid (or tunnel) to provide public green space and promote connectivity.



ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Organize umbrella organization that represents the all the different stakeholders in the Jefferson street corridor to support equitable mixed-use development that encourages small business, affordable housing, and a robust workforce.

Incorporate an additional layer of easily implementable land use policy and design standards that capture the vision, culture, and character of the Jefferson street corridor.



OPEN SPACE & GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE

Prioritize and Identify outcomes across planning efforts by collaborating, coordinating across departments to achieve design consensus

Identify funding and other key resources for projects, initiatives, and programs that require creative financing and/or traditional funding channels

Develop an implementation strategy that promotes a comprehensive planning process for community programming and supports maintenance effort.



ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT

Build upon and continue the rich culture of arts and entertainment along Jefferson Street and the surrounding community

Connect community and create a sense of place through transformed highway tunnels and bridges

Foster an alliance between anchoring institutions and community, particularly around arts-related activities and decisions (i.e.: Arts Task Force)




AFFORDABILITY

Identify residential areas and "sacred" spaces for protection and encourage resident engagement in community decision-making.






BIKE ROUTES EXISTING




BIKE ROUTES PROPOSED


