


Black Victims and Suspects as Reported to MNPD: Homicide Incidents Reported 1/1/2017 - 12/31/2017





Gunshot Injury Incident Density and Victim / Suspect Demographics



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

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




Aggravated Assault Incident Density and Victim / Suspect Demographics

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










Street Robbery Incident Density and Victim / Suspect Demographics

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


Black Victims and Suspects as Reported to MNPD: Street Robbery Incidents Reported 1/1/2017 - 12/31/2017



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

Carjacking Incident Density and Victim / Suspect Demographics


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

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




Market Robbery Incident Density and Victim / Suspect Demographics


White Market Robbery Victims


Black Market Robbery Victims
Black Market Robbery Suspects*








White Violent Incident Victims


Black Violent Incident Victims
Black Violent Incident Suspects*








Residential Burglary Incident Density and Victim / Suspect Demographics


White Residential Burglary Victims


Black Residential Burglary Victims
Black Residential Burglary Suspects*











UCR Part I Incidents per 100,000 Persons, 1997 - 2017




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Annual UCR Part I Incident Counts, Actual vs. Projected from 1997 Crime Rate
