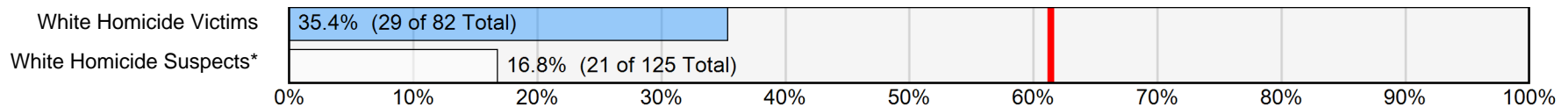

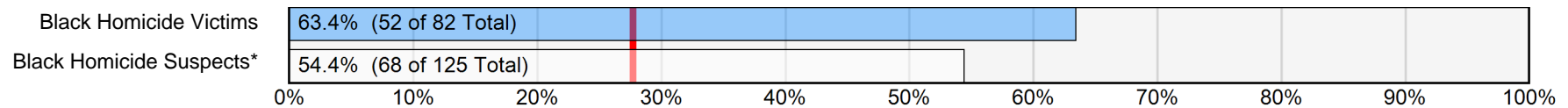

## Residential Burglary Density Map and Victim / Suspect Report 1/1/2019 - 12/31/2019

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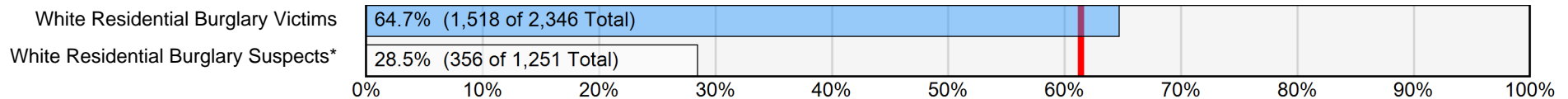

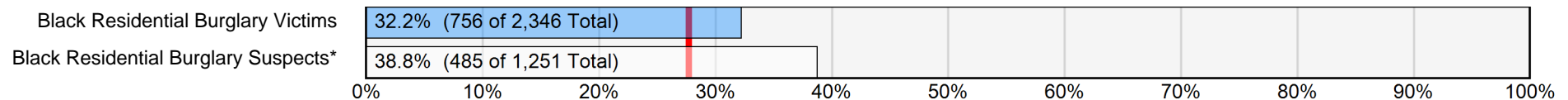

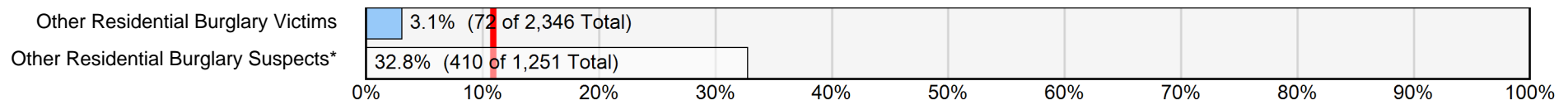

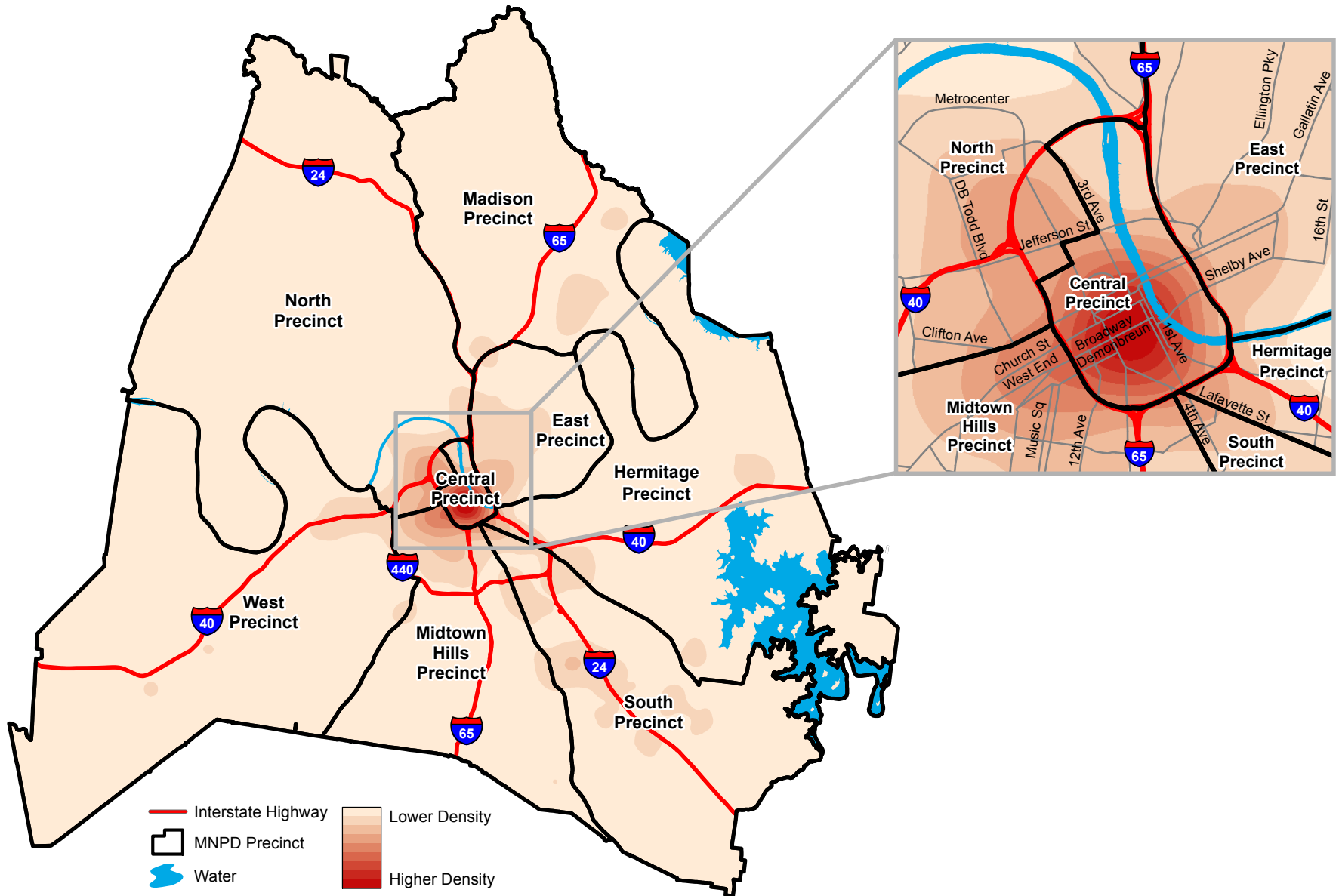

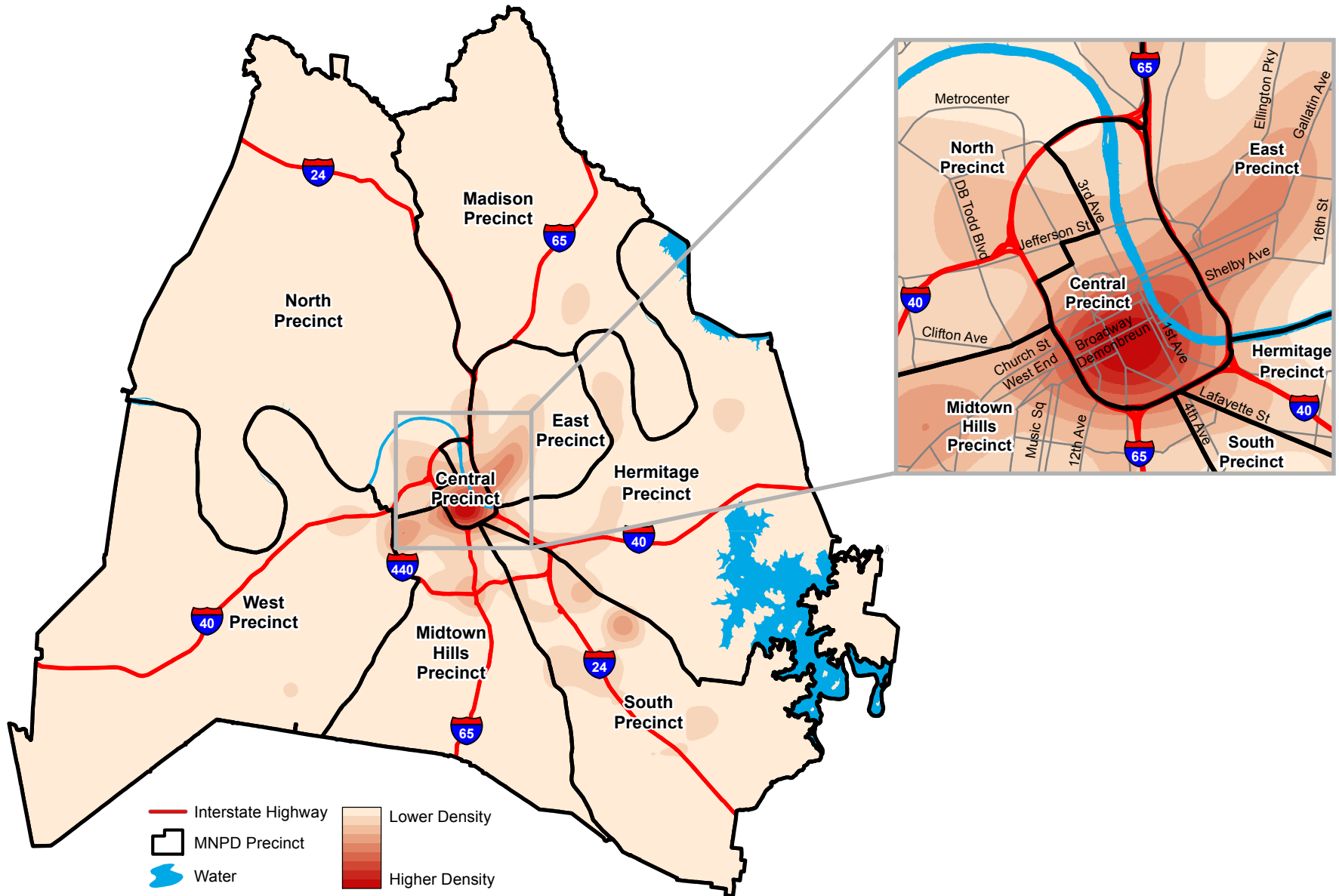

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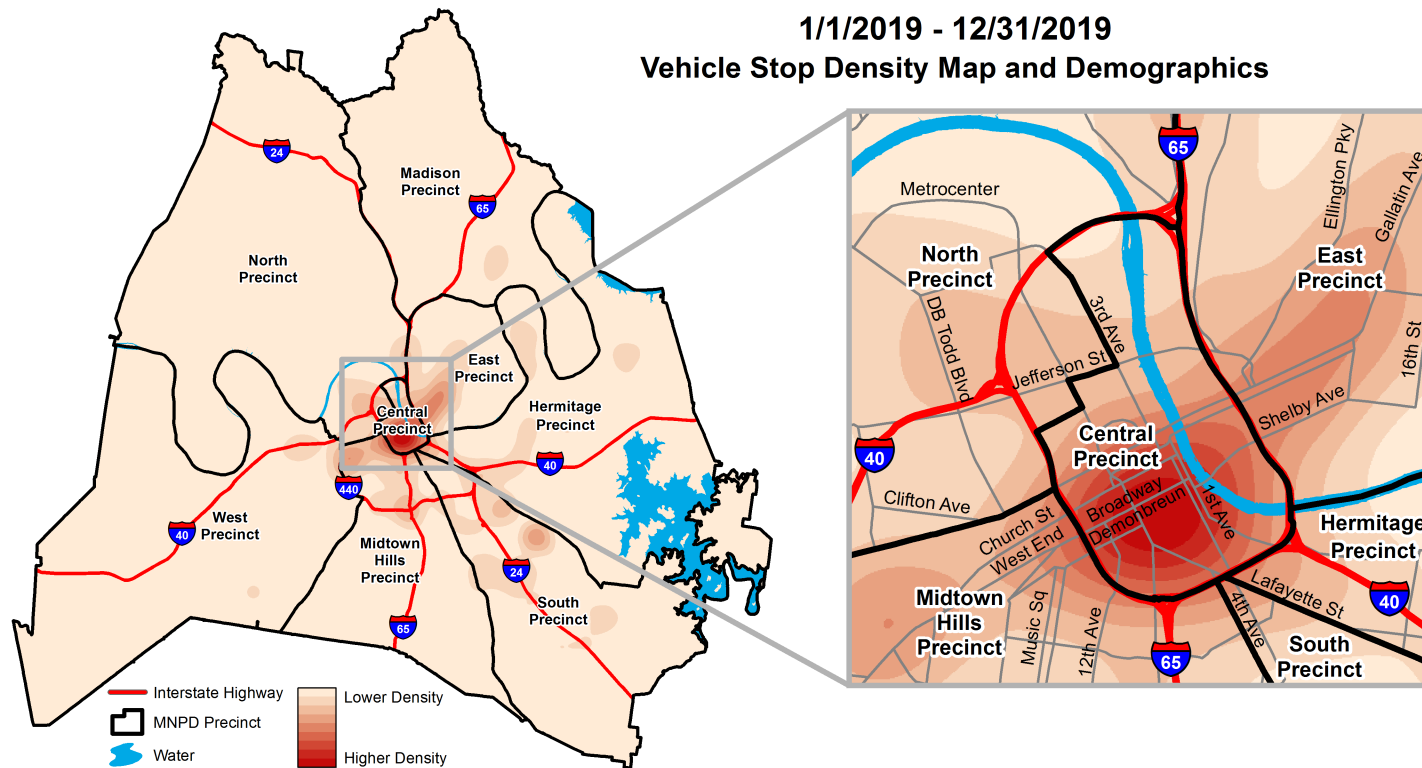

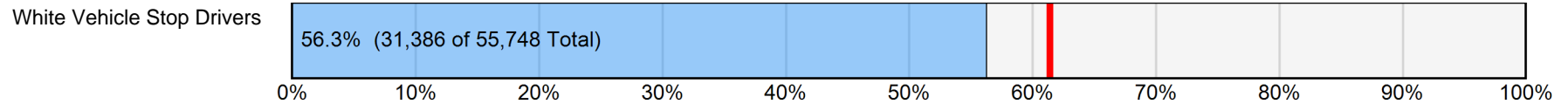

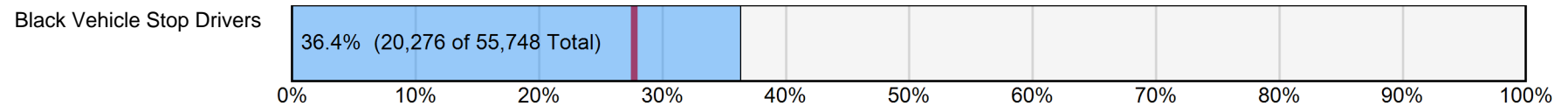

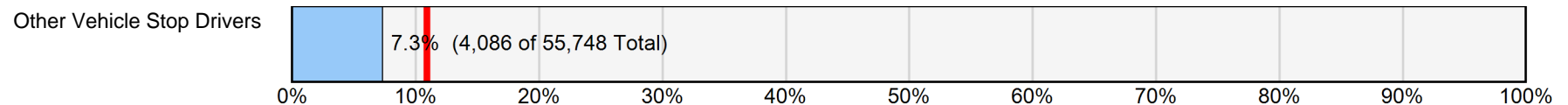
## Black Drivers Stopped: 1/1/2019 - 12/31/2019

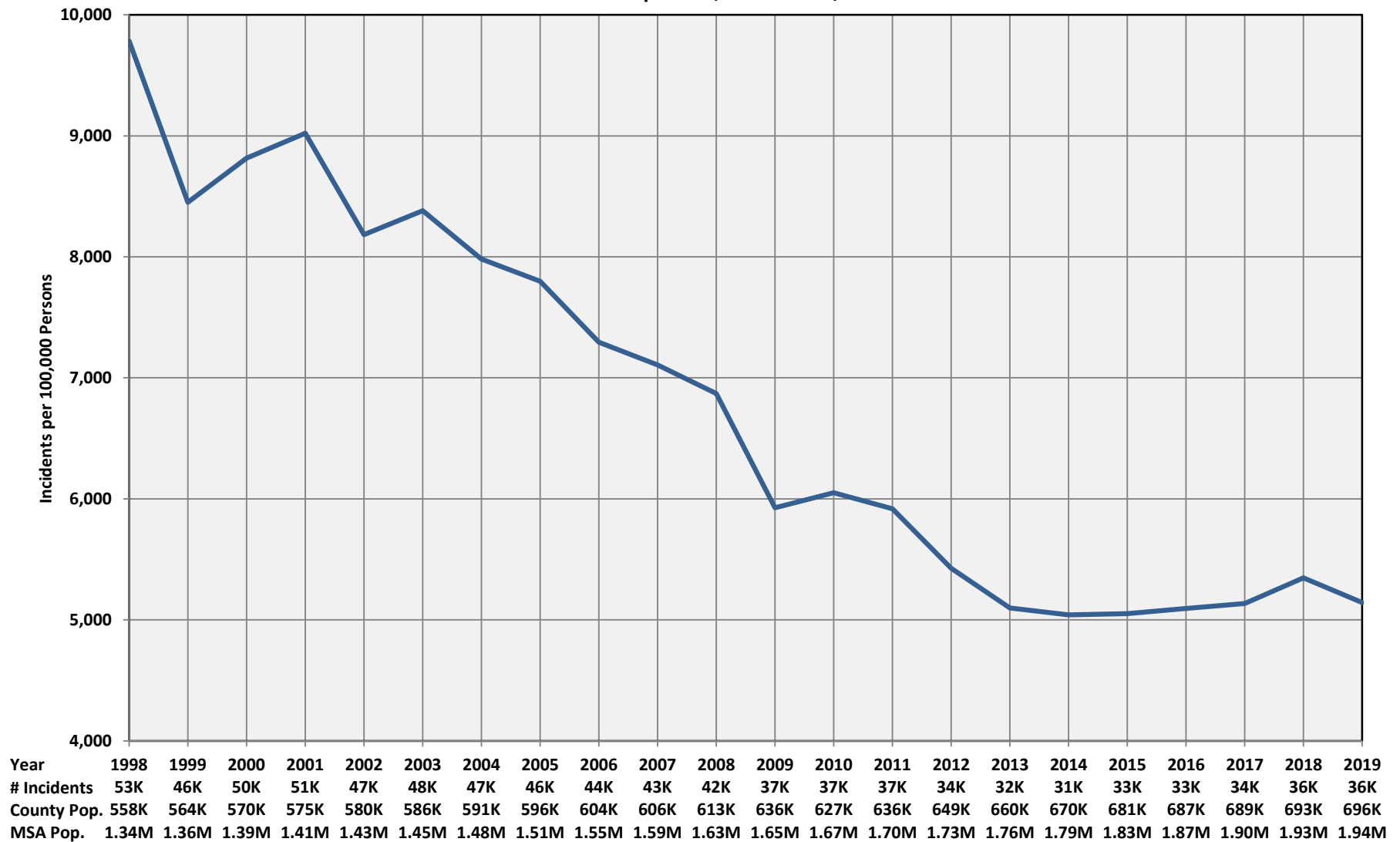

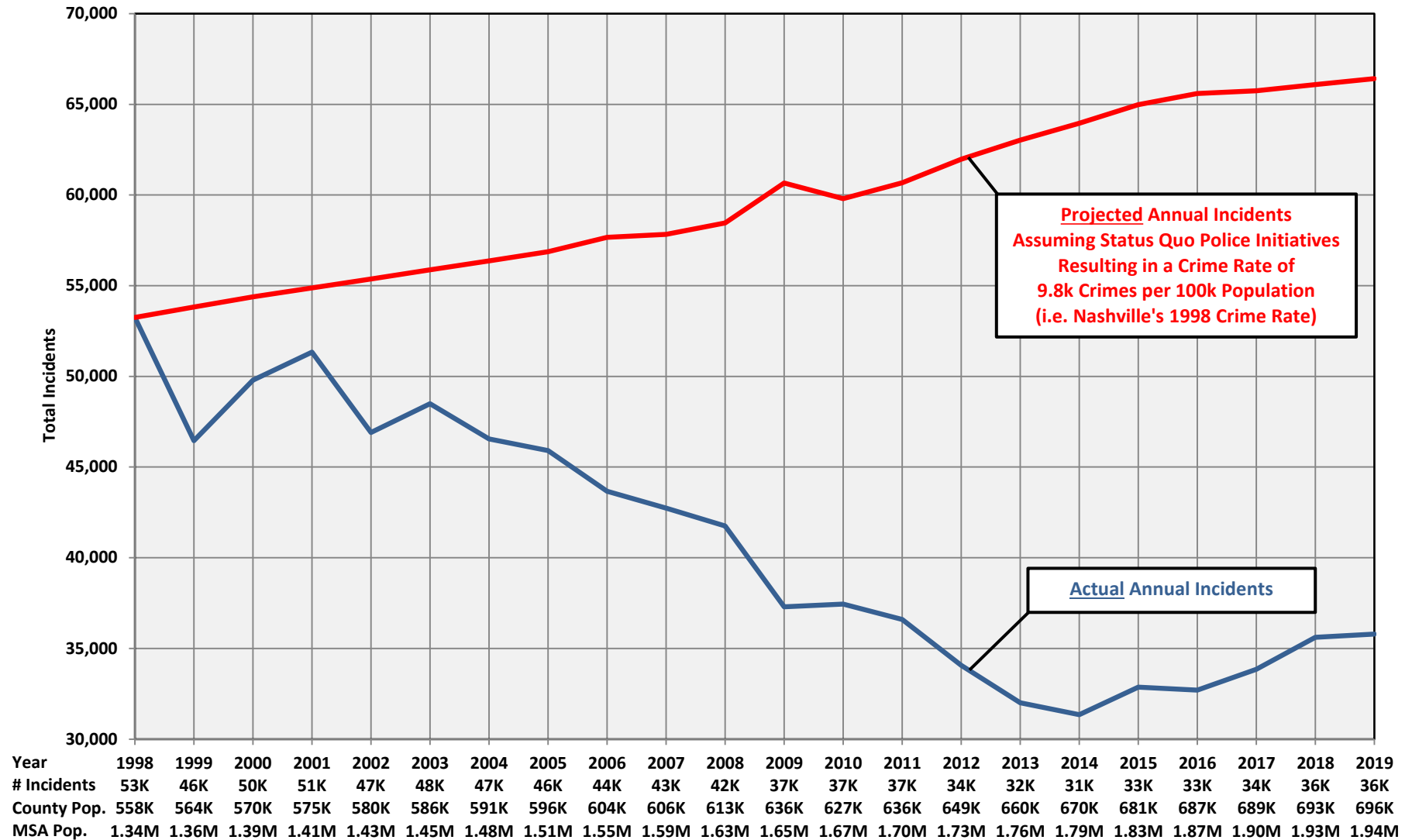

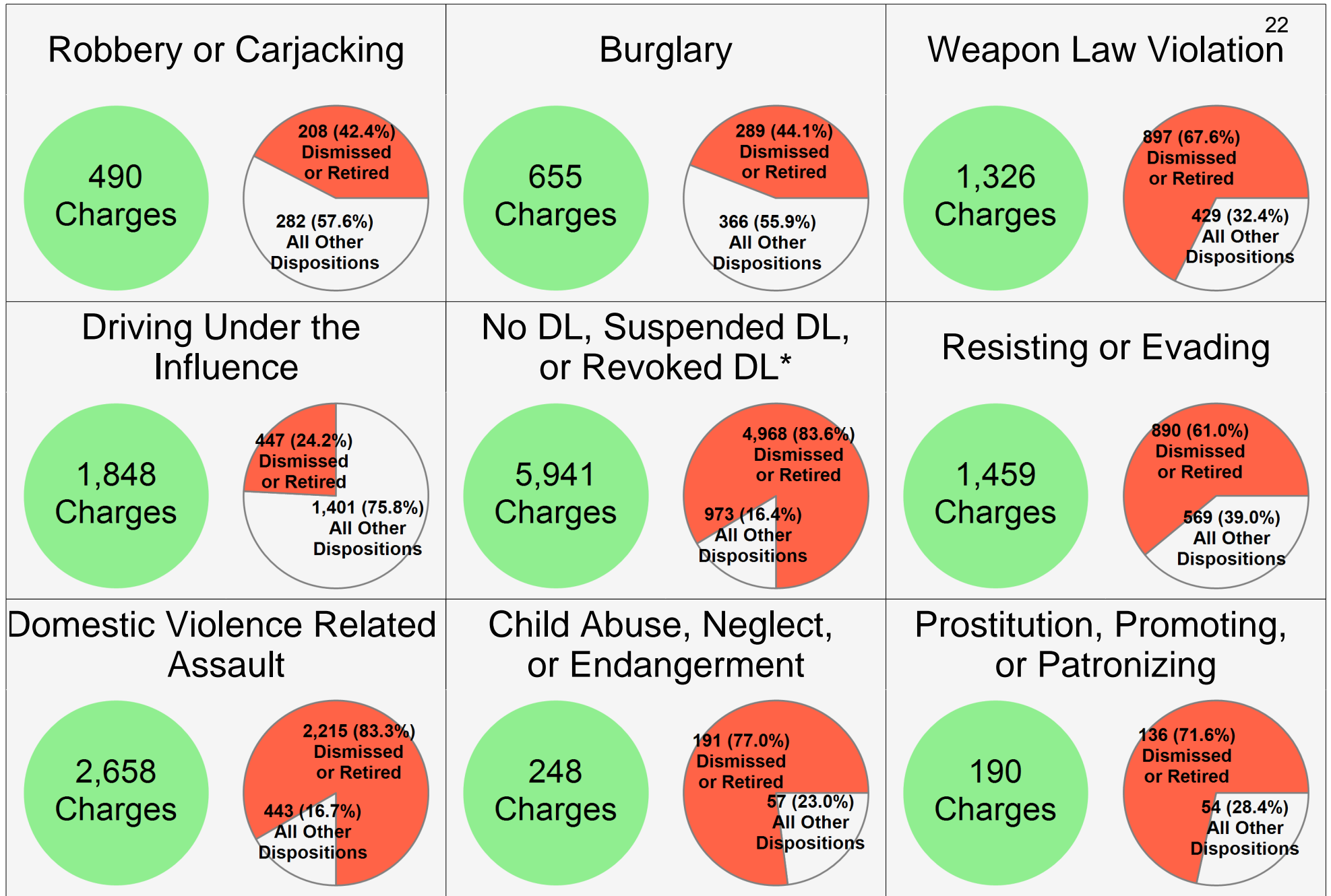


Annual UCR Part I Incident Counts, Actual vs. Projected from 1998 Crime Rate
