Residents commit to a minimum 90-day stay. Residents are expected to diligently pursue legitimate, adequate, secure income and long-term housing. Residents are required to participate in agency programming and complete household responsibilities.

Offers online application assistance for those that are not computer literate, bus passes to/from job interviews and to/from jobs. We are the only driver license assistance program that assists with out of county/state issues, certification for special test-taking accommodation, and eyeglasses for the vision test.
