Purpose: To establish guidelines for the restoration of drainage systems.

Policy: It is the goal of MWS to restore the intended function of the drainage system as adjusted to current design standards and criteria.

- Restoring systems inside the public right-of-way.

MWS will maintain drainage systems within the public right-of-way to restore the intended system functionality irrespective of customer approval.
- Restoring systems outside the public right-of-way without customer approval

MWS will maintain drainage systems outside of the public right-of-way to restore the intended system functionality when the drainage system conveys stormwater runoff from a public right-of-way and the work can be performed within a drainage easement.
- Systems constructed or modified without MWS approval

MWS reserves the right to require the property owner to remove any unauthorized construction and to restore the area to a proper condition. If corrective action is not taken, MWS reserves the right to initiate legal action.
