## The Water Bill

The water is measure in units of CCF. One CCF equals 748 gallons. Jasmine's bill was for seven CCFs. Diego's bill was for 3740 gallons.

## Saving Water $=$ Saving Money

The United States Environmental Protection Agency, the U.S EPA, estimates that each person uses about 88 gallons of water a day. Here are the estimated amounts of water for household use:

- Showers and bathroom faucets use 2.2 gallons per minute.
- A toilet uses 1.28 gallons for each flush.
- A full bathtub uses 70 gallons.
